HOW CAN IT BE ACCOMPLISHED?

- 1. Give a personal testimony.
- 2. Share a Spiritual Laws Tract.
- 1. Pray for your players.
- 2. Take them out to lunch or breakfast
- 1. Share my coaching philosophy at a team meeting.
- 2. Meet privately with each player at least once during the season.
- 3. Meet my player's needs.
- 1. Have an end of the season party.
- 2. Invite Sunday School Class members to come out and support the team as fans.
- 3. Invite new church members to play on my team.
- 1. Ask team members to invite an unchurched friend to play.
- 2. Invite folks from the church and Sunday School prospect file to play.
- 1. See that everyone plays at least half the game.
- 2. Start everyone at least a few times each season.
- 3. Praise players for a job well done.
- 4. Encourage players when they are down.
- 5. Teach skills of the game.
- 1. Share about my desire for them to conform to the image of Christ.
- 2. Encourage them to attend Sunday School and Worship.
- 3. Be a Christ-like example.

See that His name is glorified and honored.

For me to be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ by coaching my team as He would.

- 1. See that there is prayer before or after each game.
- 2. Rebuke, in private, any player who displays a wrong attitude.
- 3. Display sportsmanship at all times.
- 1. Daily prayer, meditation, and Bible reading.
- 2. Regular church attendance.
- 3. Review of the above principles and objectives throughout the season.
 4. Study the life of Christ.
